The Great Reversal

Matthew 18:1-4; 19:13-15

Introduction: Humility is a laudable quality but often quite elusive, especially in the competitive climate in which we live

1. Jesus' intention for his disciples was to reflect a maturity of faith
2. From our earliest years we are encouraged to seek the accolades of others
3. What was Jesus saying and doing by taking the child in their midst?
4. The measure of greatness is humility
5. The Greek word for change means exactly that – a change of heart
6. You must become like a child. You must go through the great reversal
7. Selfish ambition must be swallowed up in humble trust
8. For the more we seek His wisdom, rather than our own, the better off we'll be
