

IN-PERSON WORSHIP AT SUPPLEE

- We focus on providing a safe, in-person worship, following federal, state, and local guidelines in the sanctuary.
- We provide on-line worship services for those staying home.

ATTENDING IN-PERSON SERVICE

- Let us know you will be worshipping with us in-person either using the online form or by calling the church office by the Thursday before worship.
- We will be using the sanctuary and the restrooms in the adjacent hallway. The rest of the church building will be closed.
- Face masks will be required for everyone while on the church property. Please bring a face mask for every member of your family over the age of 2. Exceptions to wearing masks are allowed for certain medical reasons.
- Please stay home if you are not feeling well.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT SUPPLEE

- The sanctuary doors will open 30 minutes prior to the service as it may take added time to seat everyone.
- You will be asked to respect social distancing while waiting to enter.
- An usher will greet you and confirm your party is on our seating chart.

- Upon arrival every person will have their temperature taken by an usher with a handheld infrared thermometer. Individuals with body temperatures over 100.4 °F will not be admitted.
- An usher will guide your party to your seats.
- An usher will direct your party's exit from the sanctuary and the building.

WHAT IS DIFFERENT

- Offering boxes are at the entrance/exit to the sanctuary.
- On Communion Sundays, pre-packaged Communion sets containing a wafer and juice will be used. These packages will be picked up when you enter the sanctuary.
- Children will stay with their families throughout the service.
- The Ushers begin the dismissal process and ushers will also guide attendees to their assigned exit door.
- There will be no coffee hour.
- Adult Education continues as an online class using Zoom.
